

TERMS OF REFERENCE : OLDHAM'S JOINT LEADERSHIP TEAM FOR CHILDREN, YOUNG PEOPLE & FAMILIES

Overall aim:

To develop and implement the integrated strategy by planning and commissioning effective service delivery.

1. To plan and coordinate the services for all children, young people and families in Oldham.
2. To prepare and implement plans for the effective delivery of high quality services.
3. To participate in thematic groups and on project boards in order to improve services and develop new ways of working.
4. To monitor, review, evaluate and report to the Stakeholder Partnership and Executive Board on the services for children, young people and families.
5. To devise and create improved policies and guidance for all partners to implement with their own members.
6. To address the workforce development process and oversee the common training programme.
7. To seek innovative and creative solutions to stubborn issues in meeting the needs of children, young people and families in Oldham.
8. To embrace change and assist with the processes for cultural change across all partners and services.
9. To establish the Children's Trusts Approach for Oldham.
10. To ensure that the interests and needs of all children, young people and families in Oldham are protected and promoted locally, regionally, nationally and internationally.
11. To monitor the progress of working groups, projects and thematics and take reports from them.
12. To take reports from and have accountability for projects, thematics and the sub groups.
