HEALTHIER COMMUNITIES & OLDER PEOPLE

1. Over-arching themes, eg Image
2. Co-ownership, eg Liveability
3. Tackling intergenerational relationships
4. “Safer, stronger & cohesive communities that are healthier, wealthier and actively engaged in delivering an Oldham where everyone is proud to belong.”
5. Don't worry too much about individual blocks, eg college – transport, access, joint work vital!
6. Community involvement; Community capacity building; Active citizens
 - should link to a measure of liveability
7. Sustainability issues – limited resources, access / cycling, environmental issues, ALSO, Sustainable projects / mainstreaming
8. How to use LAA to solve:
 - a. Prevention as a theme, point made regarding local comparators, - like with like
9. Mortality rates – cancer, strokes need mentioning
10. Information / Communication crucial – not just between the partnerships, but to the greater public
11. Idea – re, contact and support for older people
12. Add indicators in which give specific regard to BME Communities and / or vulnerable groups
