In all cases where the final statement was produced late, the reasons are known and well documented. These fall into a limited number of categories, facilitating effective management of similar situations in the future. Specifically the following actions are being taken; existing support mechanisms for families attending medical appointments are being maintained, to try and avoid appointments being missed, which significantly delays the statutory assessment process.
