Session 1 - Creative Consultation

Thursday 14th February (10-1pm) including a working lunch

Frustrated with traditional information gathering research and evaluation methods? Do you want a 'tool bag' of practical ways to consult with residents and service-users? The session is based upon the principles of participatory action research (PAR), a prominent approach to community development. Using tools such as 'solution trees' and 'push pull', PAR puts the research process in the hands of the community supported by the researcher(s) as a facilitator resulting in a plan of action. You will never use a questionnaire again!

Session 2 - Introduction to Community Engagement

Tuesday 26th February (10-1pm) including a working lunch

What is community engagement? Explore the difference between consultation, engagement and participation by examining the works of 'key thinkers' such as Arnstein. This will be linked to Oldham and how embedding community engagement in activities can enhance funding applications and support commissioning tenders.

The working lunches include a LAA (Local Area Agreement) 'speed dating' session introducing experienced Local Area Agreement delivery organisations to those seeking to secure contracts.

Session 3 - Introduction to the Oldham Partnership (LSP) and the Local Area Agreement

The session covers the national background and rationale of Local Strategic Partnerships (LSP) and the structure of the Oldham Partnership. This will allow participants to explore opportunities for influencing local priorities, improve their voice in shaping services and securing funding.

Session 4 - Community Development Worker Master-Class

Monday 10th March (10-12pm) followed by lunch

An opportunity for Development Worker's to gain an update on Oldham's current and emerging themes and strategies including the Community Engagement Strategy and the developing Cohesion Strategy. There will be an opportunity for participants to develop practical consultation tools, find out about further training opportunities and network with fellow-workers.
